
Archaeological tour of Ljubljana, of the Ljubljana City Museum and of the National Museum of Slovenia – Lapidarium (3 h)



A trail through the center of Ljubljana tracing the 2000-year-old heritage of *colonia Iulia Emona*. The trail leads the visitor through 13 sites of the colony dating from the 1st to the 6th century CE (a Roman domus, Emona's first baptistery, Roman town-wall etc.). It includes the visit of the Ljubljana City Museum and ends in the Lapidarium of the National Museum of Slovenia.
